

INFORMATION IN REGARD TO THE TYPE AND VOLUME OF THE PERSONAL DATA PROCESSED BY THE CONTROLLER BOLSA EOOD VIA SRUVAILANCE

In accordance with GDPR, we hereby inform you that there is surveillance equipment on the territory of the property, owned by BOLSA EOOD.

Please read the information given below in regard with the type and volume of the personal data we collect and process, as well as its protection and your rights.

I. Controller's information and contact details:

BOLSA EOOD UIC: 131568518, with seat and management address in Sofia, 18 Tsar Osvoboditel blvd., represented by the manager Stanislava Georgieva;

II. Purposes of the data processing

BOLSA EOOD has installed and uses surveillance equipment on the bases of its legitimate interests, for the purposes of providing a secure surroundings on the territory of the property and the building of the Controller. Some of the videotapes are stored and may be opened in case of a breach of the internal rules.

III. Recipients of personal data:

In the Controller's organization recipients of personal data are: the manager of the company.

Outside of the controller's organization: an outsourcing security company.

The Controller is obliged by the Bulgarian law to provide the police with the videotapes in the cases when a crime has been committed and when the competent bodies have requested the videotapes under the applicable procedure.

IV. Terms for processing personal data:

The term for storage of the videotapes is 2 months.

V. Points of surveillance

- There are video cameras in the following locations:
- At the entrance of the property;
- At the entrance of the building;
- In the common spaces on fl. 1 and fl. 2;
- In the garden;
- In the storage premises;
- In the Kitchen;

VI. Rights of the data subjects

You have the following rights:

- **Right of information and access** to your personal data: you have the right to receive from us confirmation as to whether or not your personal data is being processed, and, where that is the case, access to the personal data. Since the controller does not use face recognition software, if you wish to know whether there is a tape of you, you must state a specific date and hour for which you would like to receive information. Due to lack of software for face blur, if you wish to see a videotape containing information about you, you can only do that after all other subject of personal data on that tape have given their preliminary explicit consent;
- **Right to rectification**: in cases where you have found the personal data we have for you is incomplete or inaccurate you have the right to request its completion or rectification.
- **Right to erase** (to the extent that processing is necessary for the Controller to execute legal obligation, for reasons of public interests for legal claims). Videotape containing personal data of other subject may be erased only with the consent of those subjects;
- **Right to restriction of processing** (to the extent that processing is necessary for the Controller to execute legal obligation, for reasons of public interests for legal claims): in the cases when you have concluded that the personal data is not correct or when you have doubts about the lawfulness of the data processing you may request the Collector to pause the processing of your data until the issues have been resolved;

- **Right to object:** you have the right to object against the processing when you have doubts about the legitimate interest of the Controller for that specific processing;
- **Right to data portability:** you have the right to receive the personal data concerning you in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and you have the right to transmit that data to another controller, if the processing is based on consent or on a contract and the processing is carried out by automated means. Videotape containing personal data of other subject may be provided only with the consent of those subjects.
- **Right to a claim** before the Commission for personal data protection;
